Summary Funding: Division C outlines \$695.9B in total funding for DoD, includes:

- \$627.3B in DoD base and discretionary funding
- \$68.6B in Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) funding

Army National Guard

- Recommends ARNG end strength at 336,500 soldiers
- \$862M for UH-60 Black Hawk M model helicopters for the Army
 - \$119M program increase above FY21 request,
 - FY21 request included \$492M for 23 UH-60M aircraft for the ARNG
 - Program increase includes \$141M for 6 additional HH-60M for ARNG
- \$165.1M to modernize UH-60 A and L model (UH-60V) helicopters for the Army
 - Consistent with FY21 PB request
- \$792M to modernize AH-64 Apache Block IIIA helicopters for the Army
- \$169.4M for AH-64 Apache Block IIIB advanced procurement for the Army
- \$320.7M for CH-47 Chinook helicopters for the Army
- \$47.3M for CH-47 Chinook advanced procurement for the Army
- \$100M for ARNG HMMWV modernization program
- \$884.4M for Joint Light Tactical Vehicles (JLTVs) for the Army
 - Consistent with FY21 request, which included \$95.8M designated for the ARNG
- \$968M for the Abrams Upgrade Program to modernize M1 Abrams tanks for the Army

Air National Guard

- Recommends ANG end strength at 108,100 airmen (400 more than FY20 levels)
- \$797M for C-130J Super Hercules aircraft designated for the ANG and AFRC
 - Includes \$570M for 6 C-130Js designated to 'only' the ARNG
- \$265.5M for C-130 modernization
 - Includes \$180M for NP2000 propeller upgrades
 - Includes \$79M for T-56 Series 3.5 engine modifications
- \$5.6B for F-35A Lightning II aircraft for the Air Force
- \$1.2B for F-15EX aircraft for the Air Force
- \$2.6B for KC-46A Pegasus aircraft for the Air Force
- \$909.9M for HH-60W Combat Rescue Helicopters for the Air Force

Joint-Personnel

- Three percent military personnel pay increase
- \$950M for the National Guard and Reserve Equipment Account (NGREA), including:
 - \$285M for the ARNG
 - \$285M for the ANG
- \$194.2M for the National Guard Counterdrug Program
 - Program increase of \$100M over FY21 request
- \$25.5M for National Guard Counterdrug schools
 - Program increase of \$20M over FY21 request
- Additional \$75.2M for the National Guard Youth ChalleNGe program
- Additional \$41.1M for STARBASE
- Additional \$1.5M for wildfire training
