FORMING AND ORGANIZING AMERICAS FIRST FIGHTING FORCE

The National Guard formed in 1636 as American colonists trained all men age 16 - 60 in military skills and tactics.

This Citizen-Soldier model allowed the colonies to grow without a standing army until the American Revolution.

The Guard allowed congress to distribute national defense among the several states, avoiding a large federal force.

Article 1, Section 8 of the U.S. Constitution details the Federal and state roles in maintaining the Guard.

The utilization, training and structure of the Guard changed in 1903 with the passage of the Militia Act of 1903 (Dick Act)

AIR / ARMY NATIONAL GUARD STRUCTURE



As Commander In Chief of the Texas Military Forces the Governor of Texas holds supreme authority for deployment and utilization of military equipment and personnel accountable to the Texas Military Department and State of Texas.

THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF TEXAS

Major General Tracy Norris

Appointed by the Governor, the Adjutant General is the military commander of the Texas Military Forces. Responsible for the overall leadership, management, operations and accountability of Texas Military Forces as the governing officer, policy maker, and head of the Texas Military Department.

COMMAND SENIOR ENLISTED LEADER




Texas Delegation



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
